RANGERMAIL

Check your student RangerMail by going to wwp.edu/ admittedstudent. You will receive important updates, and confirmations regularly. Professors and other departments will send email only to your RangerMail account, and often ignore email from personal accounts.

PLACEMENT, ORIENTATION, AND REGISTRATION

Final acceptance is contingent upon receipt of this information and adherence to all conditions to your admission. 	Foreign Language To continue with a foreign language and/pursue retroactive credit, a placement test is necessary prior to attending Orientation. Visit uwp.edu/placement. Advanced Placement (AP) AND International Baccalaureate (IB) Credit College credit may be awarded for Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB). An official AP score report or official IB transcript must be sent to Parkside prior to attending Orientation.
