SCHOLARSHIPS

Applying is easy, your application for admission acts as your initial scholarship application. But remember, you must be admitted to the university by February 1 to be eligible for consideration.

All students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), fafsa.gov, which is used for Pell Grants, state grants, work study, and student loans. Students may begin filling out the FAFSA starting October 1 for the following school year. Parkside's FAFSA code is 005015, be sure to include this code.
