 - b. Submit a signed copy of 2021 federal tax return
 - c. Request a copy of 2021 federal tax transcript via irs.gov. Requested transcripts must be sent to a home address.
- 3. All W-2's and Schedules, including Schedule Cs (if self-employed) Schedule S or K or a "Wage and Income Transcript" from the IRS, must be included.
- 4. Students who were NOT REQUIRED to file taxes in 2021 must complete IRS form 4506-T, and submit the form to the IRS requesting confirmation of non-tax filing status.
 - a. If the 4506-T is attempted, but no response is received, please contact our office for next steps.
- 5. To be eligible for Federal and State aid programs, verification documents must be submitted to the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid prior to your last date of attendance for the academic year (2023-2024).
