

## PRACTICE ROOMS GUIDELINES

The Music Department offers practice rooms to students for the practice and performance of music and musical instruments. Practice rooms are available from 7am to 10pm to all students with preference given to music majors and minors. Students who desire to practice after hours (10pm to 2am) must check with the Fine Arts office for additional requirements. The Music Department has 10 individual practice rooms (for one to two performers) and 5 ensemble practice rooms (for three to five performers).

- Music Practice rooms are free and there are no reservations
  
- Practice rooms are available for practicing only.**
  
- Music Majors and Minors have priority of practice room use
  
- Music majors may request the space if the person practicing is not a music major or minor.
  
- Chamber music groups of three or more performers have priority of use for the ensemble practice rooms
  
- Practice Rooms will not be hold, booked, or reserved (to keep belongings in the practice room while the owner is absent does not constitute ownership).
  
- No food or drinks are allowed inside Practice rooms.
  
- Please, be kind to others and keep spaces must clean and free of clutter.
  
- Always be mindful of the next person using the practice room.
  
- Security is a concern; please do not leave instruments or belongings alone.
  
- UW-Parkside or the Music Department is not liable for any belongings left in the practice rooms.
