

WEB ARCHIVES OF CORE WOMEN'S BIOGRAPHIES AT THE LIBRARY

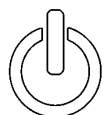
The Gerritsen Collection (the world's leading cross-cultural archive in women's history) delivers key biographical and autobiographical books and periodicals, in cover-to-cover full image with searchable ASCII text.

Works date from 1543 through 1945. Titles include:

- Anna Gordon, *The Life of Frances E. Willard*, 1912, an intimate biography of the founder of the Women's Christian Temperance Union
- Ida Harper Husted, *The Life and Work of Susan B. Anthony, Including Public Addresses, Her Own Letters, and Many from Her Contemporaries During Fifty Years, 1898–1908*. More than a biography, this three-volume set illuminates the 19th-century U.S. women's suffrage movement Anthony personified
- Helen Dyer, *Pandita Ramabai: The Story of Her Life*, c. 1911, detailing Ramabai's struggle for women's education in India
- Jacob Bouten, *Mary Wollstonecraft and the Beginnings of Female Emancipation in France and England*, 1922
- *America's Twelve Great Women Leaders During the Past Hundred Years as Chosen by the Women of America: A Compilation from the Ladies Home Journal and the Christian Science Monitor*, c. 1933
- Ethel Hill, *Great Suffragists—And Why: Modern Makers of History*, c. 1909

Works are searchable by keyword, standard bibliographic elements, and Boolean operators, with records linked to corresponding page images in downloadable Adobe® PDF

Digitized from the masters in the UMI® microform vault, the Gerritsen Collection—Women's History Online is the most extensive international view of women in the public and private arena, spanning four centuries and 15 languages. Updated weekly, it will ultimately encompass more than 2 million pages from over 4,700 titles.
