

UW – Parkside Scholarship Application Instructions

How to Apply

New UW-Parkside Students

- To be considered as a UW-Parkside Scholarship Finalist, and be invited to fill out the Scholarship Application, you must be admitted to the University by February 1st.
- Once admitted to the University, if you meet benchmark requirements, you will receive an email invitation to complete the electronic Scholarship Application with instructions and due dates.
- If you are invited to fill out the application, you will also want to seek two people to fill out the electronic Recommendation Form. Be sure to give your recommenders your UW-Parkside email address since this will help us match the recommendations to your Scholarship Application. (See more specifics about recommendations below.)

Continuing UW-Parkside Students

- Complete the electronic Scholarship Application found on the UW-Parkside Scholarships landing page.
- Seek two people to fill out the electronic Recommendation Form. Be sure to give your Recommenders your UW-Parkside email address since this will help us match the recommendations to your Scholarship Application.
- Application and recommendations deadline: February 1st. (See more specifics about recommendations below.)

Recommendations

- Only two recommendations will be permitted.
- Be sure to give your recommenders your UW-Parkside email address. This is required on the recommendation form and is a tool we will use to match your scholarship application to your recommendations.
- Allow enough time for your references to complete their recommendation and submit it for inclusion with your scholarship application.
- High school students: At least one recommendation must be from a teacher. The other recommendation can be from a counselor or supervisor of a volunteer or community organization in which you have been active.
- College students: At least one recommendation must be from a professor. The other recommendation can be from an advisor, mentor, staff member, community leader or work supervisor.
