- Submit proof of college acceptance or admission at time of award; and
- Return the application, essay, and all supporting information by the deadline.

Application process:

- Apply online or type and print the entire application form
- Include a 350-word essay on an Affirmative Action or Equal Opportunity issue and relate the issue to personal education and/or career plans.
- Submit a copy of an official school transcript with application.
- Submit three letters of recommendation from the reference types outlined in application
- Submit online or print the application and return with all supporting documentation:
