

# STUDENTS WITH DEGREES

Thank you for your interest in UW-Parkside’s Teacher Education Program. The following lists the steps for admission and progression through the program and the requirements for obtaining licensure to teach at the following levels.

**Certifications offered:**

**Early Childhood** = approximately Birth to age 8 (Grades PreK-3)

**Middle Childhood to Early Adolescence** = approximately age 6 to age 12 (Grades 1-8)

**Early Adolescence to Adolescence** = approximately ages 10 to age 21 (Grades 6-12)

Additional Licensures:

- Broad Field Science (for Biology, Chemistry, Geosciences or Physics majors)
- Broad Field Social Science (for History, Economics, Geography, Political Science or Sociology Majors)

**Early Childhood to Adolescence** = all ages (Grades PreK-12)

For the following majors only:

- Art
- Modern Languages (Spanish)
- Music (Choral, Instrumental, and General)
- Theatre Arts

Students already holding a degree must meet the following requirements:

1	Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 2.75 (includes major) with no grade less than C in a certifiable teaching <b>major or minor</b> in an academic area offered at Parkside. (See next page)
2	Match the appropriate General Education requirements. (Some substitutions and/or exemptions can be made to meet the requirements.)
3	Complete the appropriate Teacher Education Program. Education courses taken at another college or university within the past 5 years, with as grade of C or better, may transfer into the program if approved by the Teacher Education faculty.
4	Transcripts should be sent directly to the Teacher Education Department for evaluation (not the Admission’s Office). Please include a cover letter indicating which license you are interested in obtaining and how we may reach you.

**Cross Categorical Special Education Consortial Program with Carthage College**

Through a consortial program with Carthage College, UWP also offers Cross Categorical Special Education Certification for Middle Childhood to Early Adolescence and Early Adolescence to Adolescence licensure. This program allows full time UW-Parkside students who have been accepted into UWP’s teacher education program to concurrently enroll in specific Carthage College courses which lead to Cross Categorical Special Education licensure. **Post baccalaureate students** may choose a certifiable minor in Early Childhood or Middle Childhood – Early Adolescence licensures. However, a certifiable major is required for Early Adolescence to Adolescence or Early Childhood to Adolescence licensures.
