**Greek Rock Garden**

The Greek Rock Garden is a joint venture between the UW Parkside Office of Student Life, UW Parkside Facilities Management, and the UW Parkside Greek Letter Student Organizations.

Organizations qualifying for plots in the Greek Rock Garden must be Nationally Recognized Greek Letter Organization recognized by UW-Parkside. Currently, the area is designed to accommodate up to 10 Greek letter organizations. Interested organizations must complete an application, which must be approved by the Office of Student Life.

The Greek Letter Student Organizations with the assistance of the Office of Student Life and Facilities Management shall maintain the aesthetics of the designated plot area.

Plots will not exceed 4' by 4'. The Office of Student Life will designate plots. Plots will be a natural extension of the campus landscaping within the Student Life area.

Plots may contain a pre cast panel with engraved or cast plaque, boulder with attached engraved or cast plaque, or large cast plaque. All cast plaques or engraving shall have the organizations Greek letters, chapter, and founding date. No material may extend past 4' in height. No paint, hazardous material, or loose materials will be allowed. All material in the plot must be stable and generally safe. All materials, if appropriate, will be clear coated and sealed by the Office of Student Life for easy maintenance and weather resistance.

The Greek Rock Garden will begin at the end of the present landscaping at Ranger Hall working northeast along the left and right side of the sidewalk towards University Apartments. Plots will be 4' by 4' and 8' apart. Plots will be set 4' off the edge of the sidewalk. Plots will be offset to add visual interest. Landscape plants will be added between plots, as well as picnic tables, to blend in with the present landscaping outside the Ranger Hall. Natural wood chipping will be brought directly to the edge of the pre cast panel, boulder, and/or plaque to blend in with all adjacent landscaping.

The Office of Student Life in conjunction with Facilities Management will continue to update and maintain these areas as the campus master plan further develops.

All plot plans and future plots will be approved by the Office of Student Life to ensure consistent coordination with campus landscaping and master plan. The Office of Student Life in conjunction with Facilities Management reserves the right to remove any plots that are not maintained and/or relocate plots due to campus master plan developments.
