Audition Day....

- Warm-Up Rooms are available in the Communication Arts Building Music Area (see directions to room D-118, below)
- A pianist will be provided for your performance.
- Make sure you have a legible copy of your accompaniment for the accompanist.
- Instrumentalists are required to perform either: one work of at least six minutes duration, a slow and fast movement from a multi-movement work, or two selections in contrasting historical style periods.
- Vocalists are required to perform two contrasting pieces from the art song, sacred music, or musical theatre repertoire, with at least one piece from the art song repertoire.
- The total duration of all music performed should not exceed 10 minutes.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled audition time
- If you have any questions, you may call the Music Department Chair at 262/ 595-2562.

Directions to UW-Parkside: Take Hwy E in Kenosha to County Road JR; turn north on JR; turn right on Outer Loop Road. Park in the Communication Arts parking lot (at the corner of JR and Outer Loop Road). The Music Department is located in the Communication Arts Building.

Auditions in Room D-118: Upon entering the building, turn right and walk to the end of the hallway. Enter the last door on the right, then go to the end of the short hallway and enter the room at the end of the hallway (Room D-118).

Auditions in Room 105: Upon entering the building, take the stairs or elevator up one floor to the L-1 level. Turn right and follow the hallway to the last room on the left (Room 105).
