UW-Parkside Voter ID

The special voter identification card is a standalone credential independent of the UW-Parkside student identification, the Ranger Card. The Ranger Card is not compliant with Wisconsin state law that requires a photo ID to vote so the university will continue distribute the Voter ID for free as it has done since 2012.

Domestic students are able to obtain the Voter ID card at the Campus Concierge office located on the ground floor of the Parkside Student Center (SCTR D110).

Making the Ranger Card voter identification compliant is cost prohibitive as the requirements of the Wisconsin's voter identification law would require that Ranger Cards be replaced every two years to meet expiration dates.

Voter Identification cards are not a requirement. Parkside students carrying a valid Wisconsin Driver's License will not need the separate Voter ID. Parkside students who are not Wisconsin residents can still cast absentee votes in their home state.

Parkside students will need to present both their Ranger Card and a current *Student Voter Enrollment* and *Local Address Verification* letter, which is obtained from the Office of the Registrar to receive the Voter ID. Printing the credential will take less than two minutes.
