Communication Arts Building (CART)

The expansion construction project will be ongoing through 2011. The construction may cause temporary relocation of offices, classrooms, performance venues, and parking. The Communication Arts Building hosts the 700-seat Communication Arts Theatre, the Augie Wegner Studio Theatre, and the Art Gallery. The main offices of the College of Arts and Sciences are here, as well as the academic departments of Art, Communication, English, Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, and Theatre Arts.

For easiest access to the building, visitors should park in the Communication Arts parking lot west of the building. Metered parking is available.

Wyllie Hall (WYLL)

Wyllie Hall is home to the Chancellor's Office, University Relations, University Advancement, Financial Aid, Scholarships, the Cashier's Office, the Registrar's Office, the Office of Multicultural Student Affairs, Student Support Services, Disability Services, the First-Year Experience, the Precollege Program, the advising/Career/Volunteer Center, the LGBTQ Resource Center, the Library, computer labs, Upward Bound, Duplicating Services and University Graphics.

For easiest access to the building, visitors should park in the Communication Arts parking lot west of the building.

Greenquist Hall (GRNQ)

Greenquist Hall is home to the following academic departments: Biological Sciences and the Master of Science in Applied Molecular Biology program, Chemistry, Geosciences, Math, Physics, Sociology Anthropology, and Teacher Education.

For easiest access to the building, visitors should park in the Student Center parking lot north of the building or the Communication Arts parking lot west of the building.

Molinaro Hall (MOLN)

Molinaro Hall is home to the main offices for the School of Business & Technology. Academic departments based here include Business and the Master of Business Administration program, Computer Science and the Master of Science in Computer and Information Systems program, Criminal Justice, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science and Law, and Psychology.

For easiest access to the building, visitors should park in the Student Center parking lot north of the building.

Student Center (SCTR)

The Student Center is home for student and community activities featuring a variety of large dining areas, the University Ballroom, Alumni Room, student recreation center, a 400-seat movie theater, the Admissions office, Campus Bookstore, University Activities and administrative offices for student clubs and organizations.

For easiest access to the building, visitors should park in the Student Center parking lot north of the building.
