- Documentation must be submitted from a qualified individual in the field of your disability (physician, psychologist or psychiatrist, etc.).
- Documentation must:
  - ✓ Be appropriate to verify eligibility,
  - ✓ Demonstrate a current substantial impact of one or more major life activities and,
  - ✓ Support the request for accommodations and/or auxiliary aids.





#### ✓ Approval for services is determined by

- $\checkmark$  evaluating a student's documentation of the diagnosed condition
- $\checkmark$  the demonstrated need for the accommodation
- $\checkmark$  the student having made a request for the specific service.

- ✓ Interpreting/Captioning
- ✓ Alternative Testing
- ✓ Classroom accommodations
- ✓ Note taking
- ✓ Alternative media
- ✓ In-class Aide/Library Assistance

### **University Police**

- Sworn state certified Police Officers
- Patrol campus in cars, on bikes, and on foot around academic buildings & residence halls
- First responders to all medical emergencies and equipped with AED's and Narcan
- 24/7/365 (police and dispatch)





### Parking

- All cars require a parking permit
- Permits can be ordered online and posted to student account or in person at UWPPD office
- Housing permits only valid in housing lots and commuter permits only valid in commuter lots
- Hourly/daily permits available for purchase from pay and display machines
- Students not allowed to park in visitor stalls
