

## Prepare for Your Advising Appointment

In order to make the most out of Advising appointment please make sure the following items are in order before your meeting.

1. Transcripts in to Admissions
  - Please make sure that any outstanding transcripts have been received by Admissions. Having the most up to date transcripts will ensure that your credit evaluation is complete.
2. Placement Tests Complete & Scores Received
  - If you do not have transferable English and Math college credit you will need to complete Placement Testing. If you are unsure if your transfer credit is satisfactory, please email [placement@uwp.edu](mailto:placement@uwp.edu) from your Ranger Mail account.
  - For more information on how to complete placement testing, please visit our [website](#). Please note it does take 7-10 business days for scores to be received. Scores must be received prior to meeting with an advisor.
3. Download the Navigate App
  - Beginning Wednesday March 9, 2022 you will have access to the Navigate App. Please proceed with the instructions below on/after March 9, 2022.
    - Navigate is Parkside's undergraduate student success management system. Here is where you will be able to schedule your advising appointment, utilize campus resources, find study buddies, and more!

4. Schedule your Transfer Student Appointment (Available on/after Wednesday March 9, 2022)
