A. Diversity and General Education Requirement:

Students will need to meet a diversity course requirement and the General Education requirements: 12 credits from three different departments in each of the following categories: Humanities and Arts, Social and Behavioral Sciences, and Natural Sciences.

B. Skills Requirements:

Completion of the A.A.S. in Accounting completes the written and computational skills requirements via the following courses: MTH 122 or 127 Computational Skills: Written Skills: **ENG 122**

C. Foreign Language Requirement:

D. Degree Credits and GPA Graduation Requirements:

- Minimum degree GPA requirement of 2.00
