ACCOUNTING Transfer Guide

1. Transfer Policies

Transfers from non-baccalaureate institutions to may generally transfer up to 72 credits earned toward the 120 credits required for degree completion. Parkside may accept additional credits toward the degree where appropriate. Students must complete at least 50% of the total business department credits required for the bachelor’s degree in accounting at Parkside. The total business department credits include the business preparation, business foundation and major courses. Only grades of C or better will be considered to fulfill a major requirement; grades of C- or lower will need to be retaken. Only junior/senior level courses in business from regionally accredited four-year colleges/universities are eligible to be transferred for any 300 or 400 level courses.

2. Major Requirements

APPLICATION PROCESS

Early application is recommended as Parkside operates on a rolling admission and reserves the right to stop accepting applications as needed. Students likely to be admitted will have a cumulative transfer GPA of 2.0 or better.

- Submit an official copy of your high school transcript, Adult High School diploma, HSED or GED**
- Submit official transcripts from **ALL previous institutions** of higher education**

*Fee waivers are available for applicants with financial hardship; call (262) 595-2355 to request a waiver.

All transcripts **MUST BE OFFICIAL and come directly from the institution.

STUDENT TRANSFER ASSESSMENT REPORT (S.T.A.R): S.T.A.R is designed to reveal how Parkside will award credit for transferable courses. Find S.T.A.R online at <https://uwp.edu/apply/admissions/transfer/star.cfm>.

CALCULATION OF CUMULATIVE TRANSFER GPA: GPA is based on all transferrable courses from all institutions attended, including course grade of (F). A cumulative GPA is not always the “current” GPA. If a course is retaken, the most recent grade is calculated and transferred.

TUITION / SCHOLARSHIPS

A. Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP)

Illinois residents are charged 150% of the in-state tuition rate. All students are eligible; no additional application is needed.
