NURSING Transfer Guide

UW-Milwaukee offers the Bachelor of Science degree (B.S.) in nursing at the Parkside campus through a consortial program. Students in the program attending Parkside take classes at the Kenosha campus and are issued their degree from UW-Milwaukee. Students accepted into the program will complete the same curricular requirements as students enrolled on the UW-Milwaukee campus and meet the same eligibility requirements for admission to the nursing major.

1. Transfer Policies

Students transferring from non-baccalaureate institutions to UW baccalaureate-granting institutions may generally transfer up to 72 credits earned at non-baccalaureate institutions toward the credits required for degree completion. UW institutions may accept additional credits toward the degree where appropriate.

2. Major Requirements

Application information and eligibility criteria for the major can be found at <http://uwp.edu/catalog-pdfs/nurs.pdf>. Pre-nursing students who seek to enter the nursing major are required to file an application with the nursing advisor. The College of Nursing Undergraduate Program Committee reviews the application and makes recommendations for admission.

Courses may be repeated only once. No more than three required courses may be repeated. All credit for required courses must have been earned in the 10 years preceding progression into the nursing major. Grades of less than 2.0 (C) must be replaced by grades greater than 2.0 (C) no later than August for fall applicants.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Early application is recommended as Parkside operates on a rolling admission and reserves the right to stop accepting applications as needed. Students likely to be admitted will have a cumulative transfer GPA of 2.0 or better.

- Submit application fee*
- Submit an official copy of your high school transcript, Adult High School diploma, HSED or GED**
- Submit official transcripts from **ALL previous institutions** of higher education**

*Fee waivers are available for applicants with financial hardship; call (262) 595-2355 to request a waiver.

All transcripts **MUST BE OFFICIAL and come directly from the institution.

CALCULATION OF CUMULATIVE TRANSFER GPA

Parkside calculates GPA based on all transferrable courses from all institutions attended, including the course grade of (F). A cumulative GPA is not always the “current” GPA at. If a course is retaken, the most recent grade is calculated and transferred.

TUITION / SCHOLARSHIPS

A. Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP)

Illinois residents are charged 150% of the in-state tuition rate. All students are eligible; no additional application is needed.
