DEMOGRAPHIC DATA, GIS

Based on the US Census-American Community Survey 2013-2017 5-Year Estimates, we compiled the following basic demographics of women in our community. The data covers Kenosha County, Racine County and Wisconsin statewide.

PERCENTAGE OF WOMEN IN THE POPULATION (Table 1)

According to the data, 50.5% of the population in Kenosha County is female while the percentage is the same in Racine County. The percentage statewide is just a bit lower, 50.3%.

RACE AND ETHNICITY (Table 2)

In Kenosha County, 85.3% of women are White while 7.8% of women are African Americans. Asian, American Indian and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders are rather small, they count for 1.4%, 0.5% and 0.01% respectively. Hispanic counts for 12.4% of female population.

In Racine County, 80.1% of women are White while 10.9% of women are African Americans. Asian, American Indian and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders are rather small, they count for 1.4%, 0.5% and 0.06% respectively. Hispanic counts for 12.4% of female population.

Statewide, the pattern is similar. However, the percentage of White women is higher (85.9%) while the percentage of African American is lower (6.5%). The percentage of Asian women is almost doubled (2.7%). Hispanic counts for 6.3% of female population, much lower than both Kenosha and Racine.

MARITAL STATUS (Table 3)

In Kenosha County, 45.5% of women are married while about one third are never married. 13.7% are divorced. In Racine County, Almost half are married while the percentage of never married is a bit lower, 28.8%. The percentage of divorced is also a bit lower. These percentages are similar statewide in Wisconsin.

AGE DISTRIBUTION (Table 4)

In Kenosha County, age groups below 15 years old count for 19.5% of the total population while female counts for 9.4%. Among those who are in between 15 to 64 years, the percentage is 67.7% while female courts for 33.9%. The total population of those who are 65 years and older counts for 12.8% while female counts for 7.3%.

In Racine County, age groups below 15 years old also count for 19.5% of the total population while female counts for 9.5%. Among those who are in between 15 to 64 years, the percentage is 65.3% while female courts for 32.6%. The total population of those who are 65 years and older counts for 15.1% while female counts for 8.5%.

In Wisconsin, age groups below 15 years old also count for 18.6% of the total population while female counts for 9.1%. Among those who are in between 15 to 64 years, the percentage is 65.7% while female courts for 32.6%. The total population of those who are 65 years and older counts for 15.5% while female counts for 8.5%.

Both Kenosha and Racine Counties have a younger population in compare to statewide while Kenosha has a youngest population.

FERTILITY (Table 5)

In Kenosha County, among 40447 women who are 15 to 50 years, 2020 gave a birth in the past 12 months. The percentage is 4.99%. However, among those who gave birth, 44.2% were not married.

In Racine County, among 43479 women who are 15 to 50 years, 2515 gave a birth in the past 12 months. The percentage is 5.78%. However, among those who gave birth, 37.3% were not married.

In Wisconsin, among 1312355 women who are 15 to 50 years, 67517 gave a birth in the past 12 months. The percentage is 5.15%. However, among those who gave birth, 32.2% were not married.

DISABILITY (Table 6)

In Kenosha County, the number of women who are disabled is 10960. It counts for 6.6% of the total population of 165980 and 13.0% of the total female population.

In Racine County, the number of women who are disabled is 12866. It counts for 6.7% of the total population of 190815 and 13.2% of the total female population.

In Wisconsin, the number of women who are disabled is 340085. It counts for 6.0% of the total population of 5691138 and 11.8% of the total female population.
