Tour Argonne National Laboratory in Lemont, Illinois Tuesday, October 15, 2019 - from 8 am to 4:30 pm



Argonne is a multidisciplinary science and engineering research center where talented scientists and engineers work together to answer the biggest questions facing humanity, from how to obtain affordable clean energy to protecting ourselves and our environment. Let's see them in action!

We will be taking a bus tour of the site followed by two walking tours. The first tour is of The Advanced Proton Source, one of the most technologically complex machines in the world. Scientists come from all over the world to use it to carry out experiments that promise new discoveries. Next, we will see the Nuclear Energy Exhibition Hall that showcases Argonne's rich heritage in the development of nuclear reactors. We will see displays of numerous artifacts from Fermi's time to the present, models of several types of reactors, and additional screens that showcase both reactor development history and current Argonne research in advanced reactors, medical isotopes, nuclear fuel cycle technologies and research reactor conversion.
