At 1:00 we will walk a block or so to ***Russian Tea Time***, a restaurant we have enjoyed before on our visits to Chicago. Russian Tea Time is a Chicago landmark restaurant located in the heart of Chicago’s artistic district. Chef-Owner Klara Muchnik, originally from Uzbekistan, has successfully managed to infuse Central Asian flavors into the menu. Mahogany birch wood, brass samovars (ancient tea urns), modest but classy brass light fixtures, slightly-dimmed lights and heart-warming balalaika music create a very elegant and intimate atmosphere that is perfect for all kinds of diners.
