# View Fall Colors from the East Troy (WI) Railroad Thursday, October 19, 2017

Join A.L.L. for a scenic fall color ride and fine dining on a vintage electric interurban railway car on track that was historically part of the original interurban system in southeastern Wisconsin. The route is just over 6 miles long - a single track with 4 passing sidings.

The trip will consist of a two hour ride, while enjoying a four course lunch, from the East Troy depot to Indian Head Park in Mukwonago, where there will be approximately a 20 minute break. You may disembark and walk around the park. We then return to the East Troy depot where you will have time to walk around the museum and browse the gift shop. Included is a trip next door to J. Lauber's Ice Cream Parlor to enjoy a scoop of ice cream - you choose the flavor. We will then return to Tallent Hall. Restrooms are at the depot, on the train and at the park.

Our coach leaves Tallent Hall at 10:00 (be there by 9:45 AM). Start boarding the Train at 11:15 AM, Train departs 11:30 AM, Lunch at Noon. Board bus at 3:00, return to Tallent Hall approximately 4:00 PM.

Note: the historical railcars were designed and built long before current ADA requirements were enacted. Therefore, the railcars may not be readily accessible to or usable by persons with special needs. Passengers using motorized scooters, for example, cannot be accommodated. There are a few steps up to the rail car.
