<u>Jesus Christ, Superstar</u> is a 1970 rock opera with music by Andrew Lloyd Webber and lyrics by Tim Rice. The musical started as rock opera concept album before its Broadway debut in 1971. The musical is sung through, with no spoken dialogue. The story is loosely based on the Gospels' accounts of the last week of Jesus's life, beginning with the preparation for the arrival of Jesus and his disciples in Jerusalem and ending with the crucifixion. It depicts political and interpersonal struggles between Judas Iscariot and Jesus that are not present in the Bible.

The works' depiction offers a free interpretation of the psychology of Jesus and the other characters. A large part of the plot focuses on the character of Judas, who is depicted as a tragic figure dissatisfied with the direction in which Jesus steers his disciples. Contemporary attitudes and sensibilities, as well as slang, pervade the lyrics, and ironic allusions to modern life are scattered throughout the depiction of political events. Stage and film productions accordingly contain many intentional anachronisms.

The rock opera was nominated for five Tony awards in 1972, and its many revivals have been consistently nominated for Best Revival of a Musical on Broadway and elsewhere. Some religious groups have condemned the musical as blasphemous. It was banned in South Africa and the Hungarian People's Republic.
