Directions: From Kenosha take Sheridan Road (Hwy 32) to Racine. Sheridan Road becomes Racine Street; continue on Racine Street & turn right at 14th Street to Main Street, then turn left. The Racine Art Museum is on the corner of Main & 5th. Feed the 2-hour meters with several quarters; parking tickets begin at twenty dollars. There is a Parking Ramp at 501 Lake Avenue (which is a one-way street from south to north). The ramp is behind the Johnson Bank. If parking there, one needs to turn right on 6th from Main, turn left on Lake and the ramp will be on your right. The cost is \$3.50 and the machine takes credit cards only.
