

West Side Story is a musical with a book by Arthur Laurents, music by Leonard Bernstein, lyrics by Stephen Sondheim, and is inspired by Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet. The musical's dark theme, sophisticated music, extended dance scenes, and focus on social problems marked a turning point in American musical theatre.

The original 1957 Broadway production, conceived, directed and choreographed by Jerome Robbins and produced by Robert E. Griffith and Harold Prince, marked Sondheim's Broadway debut. It ran for 732 performances before going on tour, and was nominated for six Tony Awards including Best Musical. Robbins won the Tony for his choreography and Oliver Smith won for his scenic designs. A 1961 musical film adaptation, directed by Robert Wise and Robbins, starred Natalie Wood, Richard Beymer, Rita Moreno, George Chakiris and Russ Tamblyn, and was nominated for 11 Academy Awards of which it won 10, including Best Picture, Supporting Actor (Chakiris), and Supporting Actress (Moreno). It has been regularly revived in the U.S. and London.

The current production is a co-production of Lyric Opera, Houston Grand Opera, and Glimmerglass Festival. It is a musical-theatre experience you'll never forget!
