- **Brighton Woods Orchard** – A guided tour of the family run orchard, featuring over 200 apple varieties, seeded and seedless grapes along with quince and pears. *(These will be available for purchase.)*
- **Appeltreow Winery and Distillery** – Enjoy sampling hard ciders and wines in the presence of expert wine makers who will explain the process and describe the apples used to make these spirits. Tasting is \$5 extra if you wish to participate.
