## **ALL CLIMATE GROUP**

At their last Board Meeting on November 6th, ALL approved a new Focus Group (proposed by Colin Carter and Nancy Barda) dealing with the related issues of climate change and ecological/environmental concerns.

We have taken as our starting point "The Climate Book" by Greta Thunberg and several others. Each chapter covers a specific element of the climate crisis and/or possible solutions.

The main themes of the book are -

- There is **<u>overwhelming scientific consensus</u>** for both climate change and human involvement in it.
- There is a <u>serious crisis</u>, which is not being adequately addressed by national governments and other important organizations.
- Those most responsible are the rich countries (Global North), corporations and individuals.
- Those suffering the most are the poor countries (Global South) and individuals.
- Corporations are emphasizing the action needed by individuals in order to mask their own (much more significant) inaction.
- The progress made in some areas is being promoted as a smokescreen to mask the lack of progress on more important areas (<u>green-washing</u>).

The book ends with a challenge to all the readers to **<u>take whatever action they can</u>** to mitigate the crisis.

We need to discuss what action each person can take - it is suggested that this be divided between -

- (1) Action taken by **individual**s to improve their own lifestyle and behaviors.
- (2) Giving money to worthwhile organizations local, national and international.
- (3) Giving time to volunteer with <u>worthwhile organizations</u> local, national and international.
- (4) Group action alone or in cooperation with local organizations

Other possible activities of the group include (but are not limited to) -

(1) Education – reading, lectures, classes, discussion. (Prepare a list of suggested books?)

(2) Gathering data – what do ALL members already do and can we join them? Are there any

- local organizations that we should look at in detail?
- (3) Action to be taken (see above)-

It is suggested that our discussion be divided between

- (1) Important global issues <u>saving the planet</u>
- (2) Regional or local issues where we can personally contribute

NOTE (1) - Since this is a focus group, it is not expected that ALL and/or UWP would incur any cash expenses. The group would have to be self-funded to the extent that any cash payments are necessary.

NOTE (2) – Since ALL is, by definition, non-political, we should exclude any specifically political group action. But nothing prevents individual ALL members from acting or voting as they wish.
