Greg is also a frequent soloist with the Racine and Kenosha Symphony Orchestras. In 1982 he graduated from Luther College-Decorah, Iowa with a double major in music and religion, and then earned his M.A. in Vocal Performance from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Later he served in an apprenticeship with the Chicago Lyric Opera Center for American Artists, a group of 12 singers



selected from a pool of almost 500 applicants nationwide. Greg's awards for singing include four first-place finishes in NATS competitions, plus a victory in the 1984 District Metropolitan Opera Auditions.
