**George Hanson** makes his CSO debut at this performance. Hanson's career has taken him to more than 20 countries, conducting over a hundred orchestras and operas on five continents. In Germany (his second home), he oversaw more than 50 opera productions, garnered national recognition for the orchestra's Mahler and Shostakovich concert cycles, and won the Echo Klassik award for best classical recording.



**Chris Botti** After attending Indiana University, Botti studied with many highly regarded jazz educators and trumpet teachers. His early career was spent crafting his skills with the Buddy Rich Big Band and Frank Sinatra to Natalie Cole, Joni Mitchell, Paul Simon, and Sting. Chris Botti has thoroughly established himself as one of the important, innovative figures of the contemporary music world.

**Joshua Bell** received an Artist Diploma in Violin Performance from Indiana University, where he currently serves as senior lecturer at the Jacobs School of Music. Convinced of the value of music as both a diplomatic and educational tool, he has performed for three U.S. Presidents as well as the President of China, and devoted himself to several charitable causes, most notably Education Through Music.
