









Co-requisite Support and Multiple Measures

- Developed co-requisite support for Math 102 and Math 104
- Summer Math Move Up (in person, free to students)
- Added ACT as an additional placement measure (NOTE: Adding HSGPA for Fall 2020)



Math Results (Fall 2019)

- > 140 more students start in college level math instead of remedial math
- Co-requisite and Math Bridge students completed at comparable rates


Math Success Observations

- Math Move Up Strategies almost <u>doubled</u> the number of URM student starting in a gateway math (60 direct placed + 53 moved up)
- Success rates for URM students who participated in one of the Move Up strategies was <u>higher</u> (79 %) than those who were directly placed (64%).
- More work to be done to close gaps for African American students




