

5th Annual Assessment Showcase

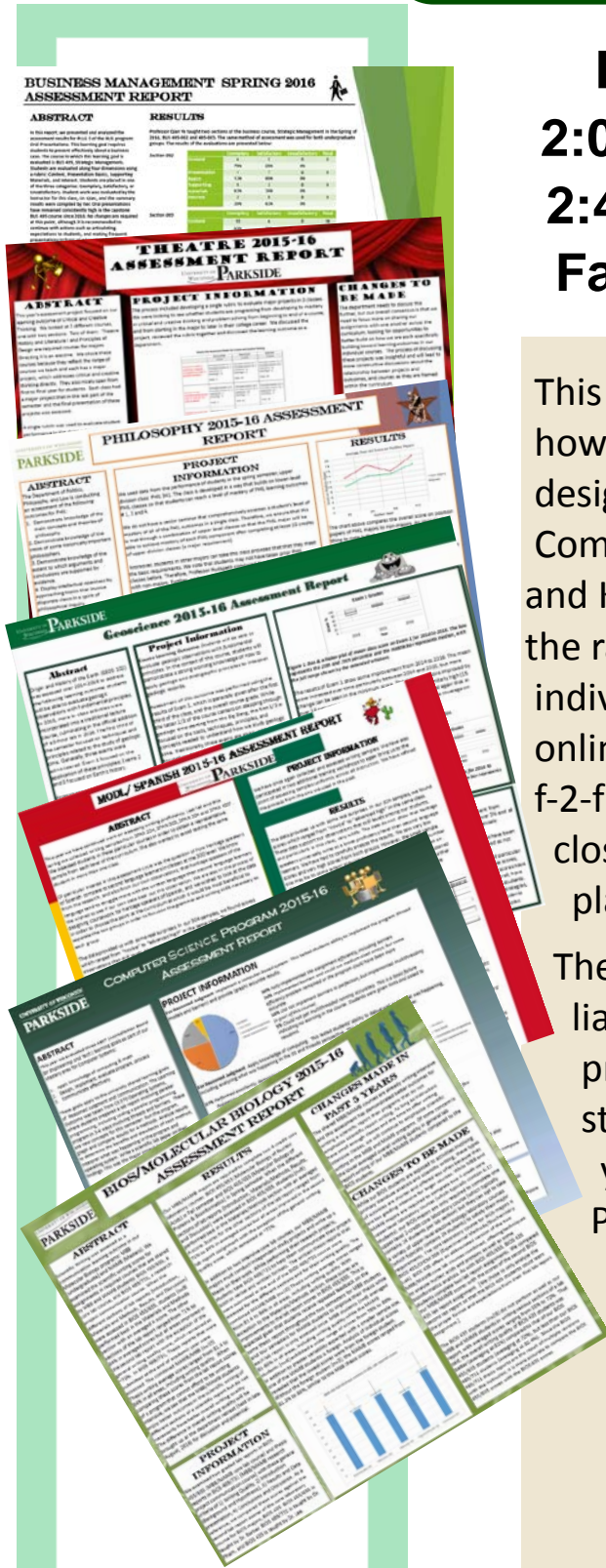
