
SoTL Reading Group

This year the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) Reading Group will feature the book *Exploring More Signature Pedagogies: Approaches to Teaching Disciplinary Habits of the Mind*. This companion volume to *Exploring Signature Pedagogies* covers "disciplines not addressed in the earlier volume and



further expands the scope of inquiry by interrogating the teaching methods in interdisciplinary fields and a number of professions, critically returning to Lee S. Shulman's origins of the concept of signature pedagogies."* While including authors from across UW system institutions, this volume differs from the first by including authors from across the United States, as well as Ireland and Australia. It looks at what is distinctive about the ways specific disciplines are traditionally taught, and what kinds of learning do they promote. Sections of the book examine signature pedagogies in the humanities, natural sciences, interdisciplinary fields and professional studies.
