



Going into Year 2 of Our Moon Shot Partnership

This Spring, teams who were selected to lead Tier 1 Best Practices will go into Phase 2 of their work. Overview of team priorities outlined below:

- **Hold Reform teams** have all completed hold audits, teams are using their discovery to understand how holds disproportionately affect certain students and advocate for change. Teams are creating policy recommendations based on findings.
- **Holistic Care teams** are focusing on 1-3 high impact campaigns to engage students in support while building out coordinated care networks. Teams are also conducting student support relationship audits to understand their student success landscape.
- **Transfer Pathway teams** are building out a data sharing MOU and will begin forming faculty learning communities to align academic pathways across institutions.
- **Retention Grants teams** have built out retention grant programs and are now looking into sustaining funding and evaluating effectiveness.
- **Equity Mindedness teams** are beginning to engage in DEIJ strategy labs to operationalize the learnings from the USC eConvenings.

In addition to Tier 1 Best Practices, we will launch three new best practice teams:

- **Aligned Mathematics** teams will redesign all existing developmental education courses, with mandatory corequisite support.
- **Academic Pathways** teams are ensuring all academic maps are updated with courses sequences that promote on time completion.
- **Access to a Second Chance** teams will look at eligible students for reenrollment campaigns and develop plans to mitigate stop outs.
