Parkside Access to College Credits General Rules and Guidelines

Admission to PACC - Application deadline January 14, 2022

- High school junior and senior students are eligible to take PACC courses, if you are in good academic standing.
**Some exceptions may apply
- Participation in a PACC Orientation is strongly encouraged for both you and your parents/guardians.
**See the orientation schedule at www.uwp.edu/pacc
- You must complete and submit all required PACC application documents for admission processing. Application requirements:
 - **UW-System Online Application** available at www.apply.wisconsin.edu (NO fee required) AND the **PACC Consent Form** available at www.uwp.edu/pacc
- A completed application for admission and acceptance to UWP does not constitute enrollment in the PACC course. You **MUST** complete the enrollment process in the student information system (SOLAR), to be officially enrolled in the course.
- You must meet all requirements including, but not limited to, prerequisites, co-requisites, and other enrollment restrictions.

Student Information

- Once you have applied to an institution of post-secondary education, written permission or consent from you is required to release any information to your parent/guardian pertaining to your records under the FERPA Law.
- You are responsible to activate and check your UWP Ranger email on a regular basis.
- UW-Parkside and PACC information will be sent to your UWP Ranger email.
- To set up and activate your UWP Ranger email account, refer to the email sent to the email account you used on your application for admission from, admissions@uwp.edu, titled "UW-Parkside Account Activation" for instructions.
- **PACC course grades are permanent on your college record**, they cannot be removed and will be used to calculate your cumulative GPA in college.
- You are required to act as responsible and ethical members of the campus community and must abide by the rules in the UWP Student Handbook <https://www.uwp.edu/live/offices/studentaffairs/handbook.cfm>

Need to DROP a PACC Course? Follow the PACC 2021-2022 calendar deadlines found at www.uwp.edu/pacc.

- **PACC course drop deadlines (these dates do not apply to tuition refunds, for refunds see below)**
 - February 4, 2022 Last day to Drop a PACC course with no fee (\$18/credit penalty fee)
 - March 4, 2022 Last day to Drop a PACC course without a "W" on transcript
 - May 13, 2022 Last day to Drop a PACC course

Tuition and Scholarship Due Dates

- Payments are made through your student SOLAR account. **UW-Parkside does not mail a paper bill.
- Tuition not paid in full by the due date will incur late fees assessed by the [UWP Cashiers Office](#).
- Tuition must be paid in full before official transcripts will be released.
- **Limited scholarships are available** Submit an online application at www.uwp.edu/pacc by **January 17, 2022** for Spring 2022 courses.
**The spring scholarship application will be open from September 1 – January 17, 2022.
**Incomplete or partially completed applications will not be considered. Make sure to complete your application.
- **PACC tuition due dates**
 - February 11, 2022 Tuition Due
 - February 17, 2022 Last day to pay tuition without penalty charges
 - February 18, 2022 Tuition balance will have a \$6.25/credit penalty added
- **PACC tuition refund dates if PACC course is dropped prior to dates below**
 - February 4, 2022 100% tuition refund (does not apply to any course drop penalty charges)
 - February 18, 2022 50% tuition refund (does not apply to course drop penalty charges or past due tuition penalties)
 - February 19, 2022 No refunds beyond this point

Technology

- You must have regular access to a computer and the internet in order to be successful in PACC courses.
- If you are in need of a computer or internet in order to take a PACC course, you should reach out to your instructor and the PACC Director to make arrangements to borrow equipment.

Parent/Guardian Information
