PAY STRUCTURE A \$250 stipend is paid to the intern after the completion of the internship.

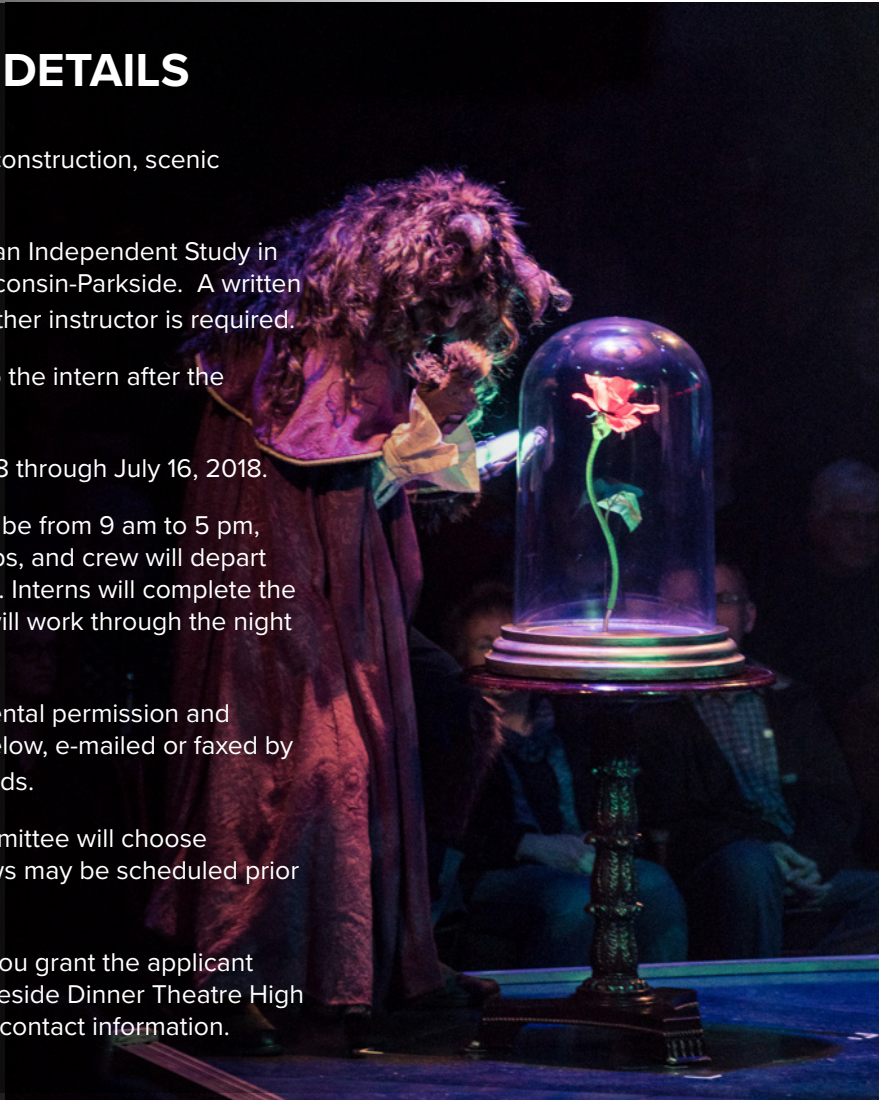
TIMETABLE The summer internship is June 18 through July 16, 2018.
