Human Measurement and Research

This certificate program consists of 12 credits including:

- Psychological Assessment (PSYC 318), 3 credits, typically offered in the fall, prerequisites are PSYC 101 and PSYC 250
- Psychology Research Seminar (PSYC 492), 3 credits, typically offered in the spring, prerequisites are PSYC 300 and consent of instructor
- Independent Study (PSYC 499), 6 credits, offered every semester, prerequisite is PSYC 300

Students are required to attain at least a GPA of 3.0 in the required classes PSYC 318, PSYC 492, and PSYC 499, in addition to PSYC 250 and PSYC 300.

In addition, students are expected to submit a pre-approved dissemination project.
