ART 391 The Art and Architecture of Italy (3 credits) & ART 122/322/422: Intro to Drawing, Intermediate, or Advanced Drawing (3 credits/Gen Ed)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

This group study abroad tour of Italy is focused on the study of ancient and Renaissance art and architecture in Florence, Rome, Venice and Naples. You'll be required to attend a combination of museums, archeological sites, and cultural activities. Professor Tom Berenz leads the drawing portion of the course — where you'll be working outside, inside, and on location throughout Italy. This course is for students who have a desire and motivation to pursue a deeper understanding of the history, culture and landscape of Italy. In Florence, you'll focus your studies in museums, and in Venice you'll explore the Italian landscape. In Rome, the group will investigate architecture and your coursework in Naples is focused on street life. Each day you'll have an opportunity to draw something with which you have connected. Through the act of drawing, you will further your knowledge of the subject matter and ultimately gain a better understanding of the history and culture of Italy.
